1.2 DIGITAL MODEL

Our digital model includes:

- > 30% of notes projected on smart boards for interactive learning
- > 30% of e-notes sent to students through our school website for easy access
- > Online classes for flexible learning
- Online attendance system to notify parents of students' arrival and departure
- Computer-Based Testing (CBT) for objective exams
- > Portal-generated report cards for efficient progress tracking

Our analogue model includes:

- ➤ Handwriting drills to improve penmanship
- > Pen and paper essay examinations to assess critical thinking and writing skills
